Subject: National Fuel Surcharge Increase

Dear Owens Corning™ Residential Roofing Customer:

Due to escalating diesel fuel costs for our transportation, Owens Corning Roofing and Asphalt, LLC is announcing a fuel surcharge increase from \$50 per truckload to \$150 per truckload, effective on **February 28, 2011**. This increase will be applied on all shipments on or after **February 28, 2011** regardless of order entry date.

To assist in planning your business, until further notice, Owens Corning Roofing and Asphalt, LLC will index our fuel surcharge to the US Department of Energy Weekly Retail On-Highway Diesel Prices for the future. Once the national average price for diesel has risen above or dipped below a tier for a sustained period of 60 days, the fuel surcharge will change to the truckload amount that corresponds with the new tier. The tiers are defined in the following chart:

<u>Diesel National</u>	<u>Avg. Fuel Surcharge/TL</u>
Below \$1.80	No Up Charge
\$1.81 - \$2.50	\$ 50.00
\$2.51 - \$3.20	\$100.00
\$3.21 - \$3.90	\$150.00
\$3.91 - \$4.60	\$200.00
\$4.61 - \$5.30	\$250.00
\$5.31 - \$6.00	\$300.00
